

CONSTITUTION OF THE OHIO VALLEY SKI CLUB

ARTICLE I – NAME

The name of the club shall be the OHIO VALLEY SKI CLUB

ARTICLE II – OBJECTIVE

The objective of this organization is to promote the sport of skiing and related outdoor activities in the Parkersburg-Marietta area; to make available to members the means to improve and enjoy skiing in any way desirable to each individual.

ARTICLE III – MEMBERSHIP

The opportunity for membership shall be available to all persons interested in skiing and in furthering the development of this and other outdoor activities. Procedure for membership is covered in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE IV – OFFICERS

Officers of the Ohio Valley Ski Club shall be President, 1st Vice-President, 2nd Vice-President, Past President (Chairman of the Board), Secretary, Treasurer, Parliamentarian, 9 Directors, Western Trip, Chairman, Membership Chairman, and Newsletter Chairman. The Western Trip, Membership, Publicity and Newsletter Chairman shall be appointed annually by the President at such time that it will allow those persons to have adequate time to properly fulfill their duties. All other officers shall be elected from the club membership by means of a ballot.

ARTICLE V – GOVERNMENT

The government of the club shall be conducted by the officers in accordance with the provisions established in this constitution and the accompanying Bylaws and Robert's Rules of Order.

ARTICLE VI – COMMITTEES

Committee Chairpersons shall be appointed by the President, with approval of the remaining officers. The appointed Chairperson shall choose other members of his/her committee.

ARTICLE VII – MEETINGS

Meetings shall be held on a regular basis as specified in the Bylaws. The President may call a special meeting of the general membership at any time he/she deems for the benefit of the entire Club.

ARTICLE VIII – FINANCE

The Club shall be a non-profit, non-stock organization.

ARTICLE IX – AMENDMENTS

Amendments of the Constitution may be made by a two-third favorable vote of members present at a regular meeting. Proposed amendments must be presented to the membership at large one month prior to the time of voting.
